- ❑ **When/Where:** Saturday, March 13th at Washington Middle School
- ❑ **Swiss Pairing System:** 5-SS, 5 Rounds.
- ❑ **Time Control:** Game/45 minutes.
- ❑ **Advance Registration fee:** \$5 if received by **Friday, 12 March 2009**

- ❑ **Late/On-site registration fee:** \$10.
- ❑ **KEEPING SCORE:** USCF RULES APPLY. Requirement to keep score will be relaxed in the Primary (Pre-K to 3rd grade) Division. Score sheets may be retained by players.
- ❑ **FOUR DIVISIONS:** Primary (pre-K-3); Elementary (K-6); Intermediate (K-8); and High School/OPEN (K-12). (NO NOVICE SECTION)
- ❑ **Top High School Individual** wins right to represent Hawaii at the Denker Tournament of High School Champions at the US Open (National Tournament of State Champions at annual US Open)
- ❑ **Team Competition:** Perpetual trophies to championship team in each division. School/team keeps for one year with obligation to bring back next year.
- ❑ **Team Medals:** Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals to top four scoring members from top three teams in each division.
- ❑ **Trophies** to top 6 overall individuals in each division and top individual in each grade, K-12.
- ❑ **Tie Breaks:** Players tied for titles will be proclaimed as co-champions. USCF tie breaks will be used to determine trophy distribution.
- ❑ **No team player limit:** Each school will be allowed any number of players.
- ❑ **Team-mates** from same school will not play each other. The Denker representative will not be determined on tie breaks. If needed a playoff match will be scheduled at a future date.
- ❑ **Team score** will be the sum of the top four individual scores on team in accord with USCF rules.
- ❑ **Time schedule:** Tournament Directors reserve the right to accelerate rounds or adjust time controls.
- ❑ **Byes:** Up to two byes may be requested prior to 1st round/game.
